CARE QUALITY COMMISSION INSPECTION— RATED GOOD!!

The Care Quality Commission (CQC) is the Independent Regulator of Health & Social Care in England. They have the power to close doctors' surgeries if they are not considered to be effective, safe, compassionate and of a high quality.

Therefore, when we had the call to say that they were going to visit us on 22^{nd} November 2016 we were filled with a bit of trepidation, but also felt it to be an opportunity to explain what we did to try to offer the best level of service we can.

On the day we had three inspectors turn up and following a presentation by us, the rest of the day was answering question after question and providing evidence to back up what we were saying. It was a very long and thorough inspection, lasting the whole day.

The ratings following an inspection are outstanding, good, requires improvement and inadequate. The rating is based on a combination of how we are seen in the areas of being safe, caring, effective, responsive and well-led across the range of patient groups including older people, people with long term conditions, families and young children, working age people, people in vulnerable circumstances and people experiencing poor mental health.

We are pleased to have been rated as **GOOD** overall. There were a number of complimentary remarks about the work we are doing, including evidence of having caring staff, efforts to ensure patients with long term conditions are regularly monitored and the relationship with our patient group. They also noted a couple of areas to work on, some of which are related to the premises and which will be addressed straight away.




